



#### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

Child's Birth Certificate

Must be 4 before Sept. 30th

## Child's Social Security Card Current child Immunization Record Current Electric Bill

If electric bill is not in the parent's name listed on the birth certificate, the notarized affidavit must be submitted as the second proof of residency

#### Second Proof of Residency can be

- VPSB Notarized Residency Affidavit
- · current utility bill
- current lease/mortgage statement

Each adult living in the household must submit proof of income

- 2. If you have not already done so, create a parent account.
- 3. Once you have logged in to your parent account, make sure that the correct year is selected.
- 4. Choose the program you wish to enroll your child and follow the program specific directions below:



#### HEAD START AND EARLY HEAD START

5. Select the "Head Start and Early Head **Start Programs** Application".

6. Once submitted, you will be emailed next steps to complete registration paperwork with the Family & Community Partnership Specialist.



#### TYPE III AND FAMILY CHILDCARE CENTERS

"Childcare/Family Childcare Application".

6.Once submitted and all documentation has been approved, you will be emailed next steps to complete registration paperwork with the site Director.

\*Use this application when applying for CCAP **B3** Tuition Assistance.



#### PREKINDERGARTEN

5. Select the "Public School PreK Application".

6. Once submitted and all documentation has been approved, you will receive a letter with placement

#### Child applying for care:

- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Current Immunization Record

All adults in household composition must submit proof of identification.

All dependent children in the home (not receiving care) must provide a birth certificate.

Each adult living in the household composition must submit proof of work and/or school & any unearned income.
